Instruments: Collaborative Projects




- ZENIT
- **Target:** Joint research targeted at technical demonstration and dissemination/ exploitation of project results
- **Target Group**: Universities, Research centres, Industry, SME, others
- **Instrument:** Collaborative projects with at least 3 partners from 3 different member or associated states (MS, AS)
 - Research projects: 100% + 25% OH
 - Demonstration projects: 70% + 25% OH

Topics (selection): Calls are included thematically in work programs

- Main focus for resource efficiency
 - SC 5 (environment)
 - SC 3 (energy)


Horizon 2020

Instruments: SME-Instrument



- **Target**: Support R&D in SME with innovation projects, contract research, single subsidy
- **Target group**: SME, up to 250 employees, turnover up to 50 Mio. EUR
- **Form**: funding for single and collaborative projects in three steps
 - Feasibility (up to 50k EUR funding)
 - Prototype development (0.5-2.5.M EUR)
 - Market entry (no subsidy, only support by information centers via Enterprise Europe Network)
- Topics along WP in industrial leadership and societal challenges




